# **Special Attention Topic**

## 1. CLEP- Center for Environmental Law and Policy Letter – Dr. Fran Wood

- A. Fran Wood received a letter from CLEP outlining their current projects and asking us (as a club) to join them publically as an advocate for rivers and streams
- B. A few specific items were asked for:
  - i. To add our WFFC letterhead to theirs to show our advocacy to their aims

- C. Conservation chair Doug Schaad reminded the board that we are on the hook for matching funds for 2011 (there is some accounting issues that make it 2011 funds)



- D. Doug also reminded us that conservation will have to present any 2012 "future funds" for approval.
  - i. A motion to join letterheads was approved by the board, then revised. It was decided (*in place of the joint letterhead motion*) that Fran Wood and Mike Wearne would get together and write a "cover letter" indicating club support.
