I. PURPOSE:

This procedure establishes guidelines for coordinating activities, disseminating information, and maintaining liaison between the WFFC and the Federation of Flyfishers (“FFF”).

II. SCOPE:

This procedure applies to all official activities that are carried out between the WFFC and the FFF.

III. REQUIREMENTS:

A. Background: The WFFC has had a long and respected reputation of being a bellwether club within the FFF. Involved since the FFF’s 1965 inception, the WFFC helped to shape and steer the Federation. Although not currently an affiliated member of the FFF, the WFFC actively supports the Washington State Council of the FFF.¹

B. Selecting a FFF Coordinator: The FFF Coordinator should:

1. Be familiar with the structure of the FFF and its regional efforts to enlist the FFF members to achieve better fly-fishing.

2. Be a member of the FFF, personally attend regional and, whenever possible, international meetings, and to encourage participation of other appropriate WFFC members and coordinate their activities.

IV. RESPONSIBILITIES:

A. WFFC President: The President shall appoint the FFF Coordinator, with the concurrence of the Board of Trustees, and shall provide necessary support in the way of official correspondence and funding to ensure adequate club participation in FFF functions and maintain Club recognition within the FFF.

B. FFF Coordinator: The FFF Coordinator shall act as personally as the WFFC contact with the National FFF chairman and the State FFF officers. The Coordinator shall act as the official WFFC delegate, when called upon, to attend and participate in FFF state, regional, and/or international meetings and will actively promote individual memberships in the FFF among members of the WFFC. The Coordinator will obtain, through the various FFF officers and chairmen, that information and materials necessary to promote the FFF to WFFC members.
