BOARD MEMBER REPORTS:

PRESIDENT Danferd Henke

FUNDRAISING Jim Goedhart

Dan and the board offered Jim G a BIG THANKS for all the hard work he has put into preparing for the upcoming holiday fundraiser and auction.

Jim G and Chuck recently went through many items from Scott Hagen's estate that have been donated to the club. These items include fly tying supplies, many rods including bamboo and spey, 22 Hardy reels, and many other brands of reels. These items will likely not be included in the list of auction items for this year's holiday fundraiser as we may have too many items for the number of people attending. Jim G will contact the auctioneer to determine the appropriate number of auction items once the number of guests is confirmed.

A discussion commenced regarding how best to raise money for the club using these donated supplies. Jay suggests providing the club membership a list of items with prices included and offering them for sale/donation. Dan agrees with providing the club membership a list and then putting the unsold items up for consignment. Neal suggests using "Spinoza" as a resource for bamboo rod pricing. Neal also suggests putting several items in the Creel Notes for sale throughout the year. Chuck suggests putting items up on Craig's List. Mike N suggests posting items on Facebook Marketplace.
