BOARD MEMBER REPORTS:

PRESIDENT Danferd Henke

Dan's recent trip to Chopaka brought up some thoughts. He learned about several classic flies that have been created by members of the club. How can we preserve this information? Jim G says there is a section for this in the "tips and tricks" page of the website. Neal says there is a book of Pacific NW Flies that contains several flies created by members of the club. Chuck says there is another book that also contains flies created by members of the club. Dan would also like to preserve all past Creel Notes. Chuck says there is an original copy of all Creel Notes. Jim G has some of them. Dan requests that these documents be scanned for preservation. Mike N recommends Kinko's for scanning. Dan adds that he has a home scanner that is quite efficient. Lastly, Dan has accumulated a number of contour maps for fishing locales. He would like to make these available on the website in the members-only section. If you have a contour map you think might be useful, please submit to Dan. Chuck adds that there is a website that has contour maps for many of the most popular WA lakes but does note that the site is a little cumbersome to use.
